At age twelve, she aided her father in calculating the exact moment of annular eclipse. Mitchell discovered Miss Mitchell s Comet (Comet 1847 VI, modern designation is C/1847 T1) in the autumn of 1847. She was the first professional woman astronomer in the United States.
