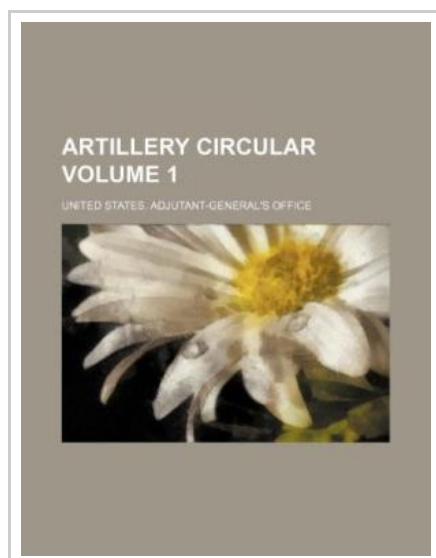

A folding prop for the end of the pole was also provided, but both of these have been rendered obsolete by the adoption of the corrugated sheet-metal prop described above. The ammunition chest, 44 inches long by 26-3 inches wide by 12 inches deep, is mounted upon the limber frame in rear of the footboards. It is made of whitewood (excepting the front, which is of oak), 1 inch thick, strengthened by six corner plates--four for the ends and sides and two for the ends and bottom. The rear side is protected by a corrugated plate. These plates are fastened by J-inch copper rivets, except at the bottom, where iron...
