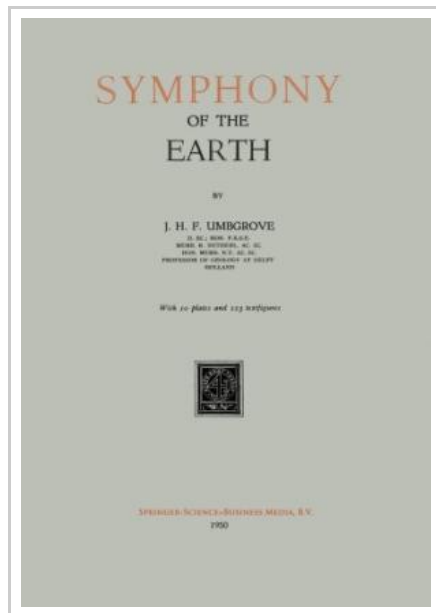




## Symphony of the Earth (Paperback)
