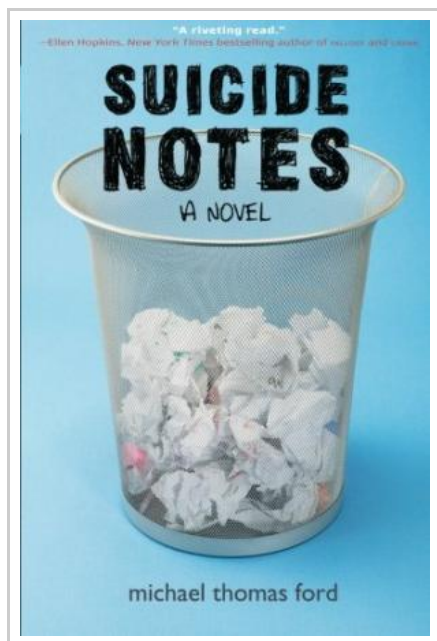




Suicide Notes
